# The little kite Fridolin

5 min.	<b>Prepare materials.</b>	
5 min.	<b>Read the story out loud.</b>	Students listen carefully.
30 min.	<b>Read the story again.</b>  <b>The story tells the children what they have to do with their brushes and colours.</b>	Listen and paint.
10 min.	<b>Tidy up.</b>	



## The little kite Fridolin

Jan sits at the table and paints.

First, he paints the **sun**. Jan dips the paint brush into yellow and paints a ball with thorns. His sun looks like a **chubby yellow hedgehog**.

Next comes the sky. Can you paint a blue sky with a yellow paint brush?

No, you can't.

Jan gets a **white cloth** from his mother and wipes the color off the paint brush with the cloth.

**Splash - the cloth has a yellow splotch.**

**Splash - a blue one.**

Jan paints a **house** with a **brick-red roof**.

**Splash - the cloth has a red splotch.**

The cloth gets more and more colorful, and funnier.

And suddenly it has a **face**.

The **nose** is brick-red; one eye is blue and the other is yellow - and the **hair** are red.

**"A kite!",** Jan shouts. **"I've painted a little kite!"**

He puts the wet cloth on the ledge.

**"Your name is Fridolin!",** Jan says.

**"When you are dry, Fridolin, you'll get a tail, Fridolin, and you may fly, Fridolin!"**
